Pre-Procedure Instructions for Cardiac Catheterization

1. What to bring with you:

- o Insurance Cards
- A list of your medications (including dosage) or medications in their bottles.

2. Medication Instructions:

- Stop taking Coumadin/Warfarin three to five days prior to procedure.
- Do not take Glucophage/Metformin/Glucovance on the day of your scheduled procedure.
- o Take all other morning medications.

3. Eating/Drinking:

- Do not eat/drink anything after midnight if your procedure is between 7AM and 10AM.
- Light breakfast if your procedure is between 11AM and 4PM.
- o Take water with morning medications on the day of the procedure.

4. Day of procedure instructions:

- o You may brush your teeth and gargle.
- o If you wear contact lenses, please leave them at home and wear glasses.
- o Do not bring any valuables, i.e. jewelry, check book or more than \$10 in cash.

5. Special points for diabetics:

- Take ½ the dose of any anti-diabetic medicine or insulin on the day of your procedure.
- Do not take Glucophage/Metformin/Glucovance on the day of your scheduled procedure.

6. What to expect:

- o Potential delays due to unscheduled emergencies.
- o A potential overnight stay based on the outcome of your procedure
